1 What is MFund II?

Databank MFund II is designed to help investors plan for a wide range of financial goals while meeting their liquidity needs. The fund invests in short-term, money-market instruments to help you sort out immediate needs, like emergency planning, or future dreams and goals.

- **Easy Access:** With MFund II, you can expect to receive your money within 3-5 business days of placing a withdrawal request. This means your money will be available when you need it.

You can rely on MFund II as your emergency fund, helping you set aside cash for unexpected expenses like car or appliance repairs. It's also a great way to plan for short-term goals—such as a vacation or side business—as well as long-term aspirations like a major purchase or building generational wealth.

4 How long does it take to receive my money after placing a withdrawal?

Withdrawal requests from MFund II typically take 3-5 business days to be processed and paid.
